- 2 **Postal Entries**  
One Entry Form to be completed per **OWNER** please. Additional forms are available on our website at [www.royalcheshireshow.org](http://www.royalcheshireshow.org) or by telephoning 01565 650200, alternatively they can be photocopied.
- 3 Please provide as much information as possible. Write clearly in block capitals. If society registration numbers are requested to comply with class requirements then they **MUST** be listed.
- 4 **Before returning your entries, ensure you retain a copy for your records.** The **Entry Form/s** and appropriate **Remittance** should be returned.
- 5 **Entry Fees will be accepted by Cheque and Credit Card in £ Sterling only. Post-dated cheques will be returned. Please do not send Cash through the post.**

- 3 Entries cannot be accepted at Affiliated Shows in classes for Shires or Heavy Horses from any person who has been either suspended or removed from membership of the Shire Horse Society or has been excluded from exhibiting for prizes at Shows, Sales or Exhibitions or from taking part in any Show organised by the Shire Horse Society.
- 4 No animal to be eligible to take more than one Silver Spoon during any one year. The Shire Horse Society Spring Show being excepted.
- 5 THE WINNING ANIMAL MUST BE REGISTERED OR ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION IN THE STUD BOOK OR GRADE B REGISTER.
- 6 The Judge invited to officiate must be on the Society's Official Panel and has the right to withhold the award of the Silver Spoon and Rosette if an exhibit does not show sufficient merit.
- 7 The Council reserve the right in offering Spoons, to award them only to persons approved by the Shire Horse Society.

Open to purebred mares, geldings and stallions, 4 years old and over. Must be registered in the main British Stud Books of the Shire, Clydesdale, Suffolk or Percheron Horse Societies. Partbreds are not eligible to compete. All riders and owners must be members of either the Shire Horse Society, The Clydesdale Horse Society, The Suffolk Horse Society or British Percheron Horse Society.

This class will be run in accordance with the British Ridden Heavy Horse Society, however, the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook will take precedence, a copy of which can be downloaded from [www.hoys.co.uk](http://www.hoys.co.uk) This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show NEC, Birmingham, 5<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> October 2016.

Qualification will not pass below 5<sup>th</sup> place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office. **No prize money will be allocated to this class.**

## SHOW RULES

- 1 **ENTRY FEES** Under no circumstances will Entry Fees be returned in the case of cancellation of entries by an Exhibitor or because of postponement or cancellation of the Show for whatever reason.
- 2 All animals must be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor at the time of entry.
- 3 All animals must be provided with ties and all animals must be halter led in the rings.
- 4 Any person in charge of livestock exhibits who places the stock in their charge in any other place than that allocated to them or who removes or alters any number or name indicating the position of their exhibit, will be liable to expulsion from the Showground and their animals may be debarred from competition.
- 5 **ATTENDANTS** Exhibitors or their attendants must remain with their exhibits during the whole time they are at the Show and must comply with and be governed by the Society's Rules and Regulations.
- 6 **NUMBERING OF EXHIBITS** All exhibits must display the number supplied by the Society for the appropriate class during judging or in the Parade. Failure to comply with this rule may result in mistakes being made on prize money payouts.
- 7 **JUDGING** Judging will commence as near as circumstances allow at the times stated in the Schedule, under the respective sectional headings and Exhibitors will be responsible for their Exhibits being in their respective Ring at the proper time.
- 8 **JUDGES** The Judges named in the Society's Prize Schedule and Show Catalogue or Programme have consented and have been appointed to act as Judges in the events indicated. The Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes for any who may be unavoidably prevented from attending and all entries are accepted upon that understanding.
- 9 **PROTESTS** Any Exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest must do so in writing to the Executive Director (within one hour of completion of judging) on the Show Day together with the sum of £25. All protests to be investigated by a committee consisting of at least three members of the Council whose decision shall be final.
- 10 **STEWARDS** The Committee delegates full power to the Stewards to enforce the Society's Rules and Regulations.
- 11 **DISCLAIMER** Whilst the Society will take all reasonable steps to prevent accidents to persons or injury to property, neither the Society nor its Officers or Servants accept responsibility for such accidents or injuries howsoever caused and whether or not involving negligence on the part of any such Officers or Servants. The Show, its Officers and Servants, shall not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss however caused, that may occur to any Exhibitor or his Servant, or to any article, animal, or property brought into the Showground, or while entering or leaving the Showground. Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may be done to, or occasioned by, or arising from, any machinery, or other article, or any animal or property exhibited by him. It is a condition of entry that each Exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Show from and against all actions, suits and claims on account of such damage or injury. The Society, through its Executive Director, shall have full and free right to refuse to accept any Entry, to cancel any Entry after being made and accepted, to refuse admission to the Showground of any proposed Exhibit and/or to remove at the risk and expense of the Owner of any Exhibit which has been admitted to the Showground. There shall be no obligation upon the Show Committee to make or offer any explanation or reason for any such action and the Show Committee shall not incur any liability or responsibility in this matter.
- 12 **BREED SOCIETIES** All persons entering, competing or exhibiting an animal in a Class covered by a Breed Society either to which the Society is affiliated or which is affiliated to the Society shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the relevant Breed Society and be subject to its constitution and rules (including any disciplinary procedures) insofar as they are applicable to any event, competition or display promoted or arranged by this Society.
- 13 **GRAND PARADE** All Prize Winners must take part in the GRAND PARADE, otherwise prize money will be withheld. This Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO Rule will be strictly enforced and NO substitute exhibits will be permitted to parade.
- 14 **POSTPONEMENT OR ABANDONMENT** Exhibitors shall not have any claim against the Society or any member of the Society in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever consequent upon the Show failing (for whatever reason) to be held.
- 15 **TEMPORARY PADDOCKS** Exhibitors to remove temporary paddocks by 7.00 am on the Tuesday of the Show.
- 16 **CURRENT ANIMAL WELFARE LEGISLATION** applies at this Show and the Society will support any action where any breach of such legislation occurs.
- 17 **PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE** Exhibitors must carry adequate public liability cover.
- 18 **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT** brought to the Show must have a current PAT test certificate.
- 19 **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. CLOSING DATE 13 MAY 2016.**
